# REFLECTIONS FROM THE RABBI

Shalom Chaverim,

Another High Holy Day season is just about here, and once again, we are faced with the challenges of an ongoing and rapidly changing environment. I am sorry to say that things will not be "back to normal" this year, but last year I said "Gam zeh ya'avor, this too shall pass," and it has. Now, more than ever, we are in need of communal supports and joyous gatherings. However, we are also in a new moment that requires new responses and strategies. I am confident that we have come up with a strategy that will allow us to celebrate, and congregate, as safely as possible. That having been said, since I'm writing this several weeks out, there may be unanticipated changes. Please contact me, check your e-mail, and check our website before setting out for services.

Finally, at this stage of the pandemic, we trust that each of you have carefully considered your risk factors and comfort level. Please make decisions that provide for your protection and the protection of others. If you are uncertain, or have any questions, feel free to contact me and your own health-care provider.

**Participating in Services:** you will have the option of coming to services in-person or via Zoom live-stream. A machzor (High Holy Day prayerbook) is available to borrow from the synagogue.

**Masking:** children between the ages of 2-12 must wear a mask. Adults, and children over 12, who are not fully vaccinated must remain masked in the building.

**Security:** We will have security personnel on-site during services, as we have in the past. The front door of the synagogue remains locked and all of our existing security precautions remain in place.

**Vaccinations:** we encourage everyone who is eligible to get fully vaccinated, regardless of whether you plan to attend services or not. Despite the small number of "breakthrough" cases, vaccination remains the most effective tool for reducing the most serious impacts of this pandemic.


