### REFLECTIONS FROM THE RABBI

The Jewish year 5780 is certainly ending in some very unexpected ways! In this bulletin you will find the working schedule for Rosh Hashana and Yom Kippur. However, things may certainly change, so please stay in touch via e-mail for updates. Additionally, you will not see a schedule for Sukkot and Simchat Torah yet, or for Hebrew School. Those details are still being worked out.

Please know that the Board will be convening a Task Force to plan for the next phase of synagogue use. Until then, here is an excerpt from the letter I sent to our members regarding High Holy Day Services:

- Our services will be a hybrid mix of in-person, livestreamed, and pre-recorded segments.
- We will have either live services or other programming for all of the Rosh Hashana and Yom Kippur services we
- usually do.
- We will limit our in-person services to a duration of no more than 90 minutes. Parts of the service that have to be cut will be prerecorded and uploaded to our Youtube Channel.
- We will limit the number of people in attendance to 25. *See below for details*.
- Everyone in the building will be required to wear a mask.
- Seating will be regulated by social distancing guidelines.
- We will not have congregational singing.
- Our cantorial soloist, David Steinau, and I will chant the prayers, but it will only be us at the bimah.
- Shofar-blowing is only on the second day and that will be done outdoors.

### **In-Person Attendance**

In order to mitigate risk; provide simpler contact tracing; and maintain necessary restrictions, mandates, and recommendations, we will limit attendance to a cohort of 25 members. This means that the same 25 people will be at each of the services together. They will have assigned seats, machzor (prayerbooks), kippot, and tallitot.

Only Congregation Beth El members will be in this cohort. Extended family will only be invited IF there are not 25 members at a service. No walk-ins will be permitted. Please contact me if you would like to attend.




