REFLECTIONS FROM THE RABBI

We are pleased to move forward with fully reopening the synagogue for services, educational programs, and social activities. The following guidelines are for June-August. This applies only to summer services new guidelines will have to be created for High Holidays and beyond (Labor Day weekend) We will continue checking in with state and federal guidelines about gatherings and safe practices.

As always, our goal is to create and maintain a safe environment and to facilitate participation and connection within the congregation. We also know that people have different health needs and different levels of participation comfort in light of the Corona virus. With that in mind, the following guidelines are designed to let you know what we have done to get ready for your return, and to help you make the most comfortable decisions for you and your families.

Vaccination Status:

- -We encourage everyone (who can) to get vaccinated for both personal and public safety.
- -Vaccination status will be self-monitored. We will not ask for, or track, anyone's status.
- -We will, whenever possible, provide a virtual option to participate in our programs for anyone who decides not to come in person.

Masking:

- -According to CDC and PA guidelines: fully vaccinated can be mask-less outside as long as it's not in closely crowded circumstances (our services do not count as closely crowded)
- -Indoors, those fully vaccinated can be without a mask as long as we are not operating in small quarters or at full capacity.
- -Unvaccinated or not fully vaccinated should continue to wear a mask.
- -We will have a sign in all the doorways with this information and ask that people take the appropriate measures to protect themselves and others.

Self-Monitoring and Reporting:

- -We will ask our members to inform the rabbi if they have been to any congregational gathering and subsequently tested positive for Covid.
- -We will ask our members to follow the appropriate guidelines for their personal vaccination status.

REFLECTIONS FROM THE RABBI (CONT'D.)

Services:

-Two ways to participate: in person, on Zoom

- -We will go back to using our regular siddur, offering people at home the opportunity to borrow one.
- -Outside, in the courtyard, is the safest for everyone—when possible. A canopy is set up in the middle of the courtyard. Chairs will be somewhat distanced, though not strictly 6ft apart. People can move their seats around if they feel more comfortable.
- -Inside we will be in the sanctuary, distanced. We have air-scrubbers and more efficient ventilation capacities with our new system.

Oneg:

- -Kiddush and motzi (juice/wine and challah)
- -Juice should be poured to order. Once poured, it should not be returned to the bottle. The challah should be cut by one person.
- -Any other foods should be pre-portioned onto individual plates or bowls.
- -Food should not be left at the synagogue

Meetings:

- -Those fully vaccinated can meet without a mask.
- -Those not fully vaccinated should wear a mask.
- -We will always provide a virtual option so that people can make their own choices


